

SAILING DINGHY DRY STORAGE POLICY

To promote participation in dinghy sailing classes, the EYC welcomes members and non-members to use its dry sailing facilities to dry sail dinghies during the spring, summer and fall racing seasons, subject to the following rules:

- 1) Prior to arrival ALL dinghies must be registered with the Dockmaster and complete the Dry Sail Storage Application* (Dinghies on dollies are exempt from the Dry Sailing Application's insurance certificate requirement). A permit sticker will be provided and must be affixed near the handle of the dolly.
- 2) The designated storage area will be determined by the Waterfront Committee and is subject to change during the season.
- 3) The full-season fee for dry sailing dolly-launched dinghies shall be the standard summer dry sailing rate for boats under 20', currently \$157.50, and will be charged to the Member's Club account. Summer dry sailing permit holders are also entitled to store and race their dolly launched dinghies during the spring, summer and fall dinghy sailing seasons.
- 4) Participating Non-Members are permitted to store and dry sail their dinghy at the EYC as long as they are sponsored by a Member. The sponsoring Member is responsible for registering Non-Members per #1 above and the storage fee shall be charged to the sponsoring Member's Club account.
- 5) The dinghy dry sailing permit shall run from the beginning of the Spring Series through the completion of the Fall Series, as determined by the Club Calendar. Dinghies shall not arrive prior to the start of the Spring Series or linger after the last day of the Fall Series unless they are participating in Winter Storage or a special arrangement has been made in writing with the Dockmaster, dockmaster@easternyc.org.
- 6) Owners of doll-launched dinghies wishing to participate in ONLY the fall and/or spring sailing season (April-May, or October-November) shall complete the EYC Dry Sailing Application, pay a "competitors off season rate" (currently \$30 for the fall series and/or \$30 for the spring series) and receive an EYC dry sailing permit sticker which they will affix to their dolly as described in #1 above. Such boats must be removed from the dry sailing area promptly at the end of the Spring or Fall Frostbite season, otherwise they may incur a Summer Dry Sailing or Winter Storage charge.
- 7) Failure to complete the EYC Dry Sailing applications, display the EYC dry sailing sticker or follow these rules may result in the suspension of Dry Sailing privileges and/or the removal of the boat from the EYC property without notice.
